PROCUREMENT PROCEDURE

SPS Habitat solicits bids for the procurement of construction-related supplies and subcontracted services. SPS Habitat makes a good faith effort to include all interested parties in the RFP process. In addition, SPS Habitat advertises the availability of RFPs for the construction of Habitat Homes on their web site and social media posts.

This RFP provides the scope of work (EXHIBIT A) and incorporates the permitted plans and specifications as part of the RFP. Habitat receives in-kind contributions including materials and labor to construct complete homes, which could affect the timeline for construction of the units described in the project description. Foundations for 5 units, (2 houses, 2 Cottages and 1 Bungalow) will be poured in October 2020 estimated completion June 2021. The 3 remaining units (2 homes, 1 Cottage) will be started in Spring 2021 and estimated completion of December 2021.

Labor shall be paid at state residential prevailing wage for Journeymen and Apprentice hours where applicable. Billing for these homes must include a breakdown of Journeymen hours and Apprentice hours where applicable.

Incomplete proposals will not be considered.

If your firm is selected to provide the services described under this Request for Proposal, proof of bonding and insurance policies must be provided to Habitat prior to the execution of a contract. A draft of the contract document is attached (EXHIBIT B).

SCOPE OF WORK – Plumbing

Material and labor supplied by Contractor:

- Place and hook up water lines to hot water tank.
- Plumb rough in to finish location of fixtures.
- Plumb in stub out in mechanical room as specified by owner.
- Install hot water tank provided by plumber at trim-out.
- All DWV in ABS. Each fixture supplied with required clean out.
- All supply lines run in PEX, If ADA sink is required, sink(s) supply stub outs must be from wall, not floor, to accommodate future ADA cabinets.
- 2 Frost-free hose-bibs required.
- · Ice-maker line included.
- All lines placed under pressure test, ready for inspection as scheduled by Owner.
- Tub/shower valve kit provided by Contractor, trim out portion left onsite with Owner. Specify: Moen TL182EP shower trim, necessary 1.75 GPM showerhead flow.
- Stub out 1 ¼ or 1 ½" supply line to sprinkler system (depending on fire sprinkler design needs)
